- a. Graduate student GC members--We need to identify two graduate student members for Grad Council. We discussed having one student nominated by the Council and one from the Graduate Student Congress. We will research who (which colleges/programs) have been represented on the Council recently, then come up with a reasonable rotation schedule for nominating potential student members

- c. Process for proposal reviews-- We discussed possibilities for efficient/effective review processes. Suggestions include: having a staff member (perhaps Aaron) do

an initial review of proposals for certain "checklist" items, including having that staff member reach out to the proposer for any issues with these checklist items. Then, 2-3 faculty would be assigned to each proposal, with at least one reviewer from the same college/related field – they would add comments into the List where proposal reviews are recorded and indicate their recommendation. They would not review the Distance Learning or minor syllabus checklist items. Instead, they would focus on more "conceptual" issues, such as the course description (and if this course appears to be duplicative), the student learning outcomes, and the appropriate differentiation in expectations for 400G and 500-level courses. For minor course changes, any proposal where all 3 reviewers indicated "approve" would be added to a Consent Agenda for approval. Proposals where reviewers disagreed, and where new courses/programs were being proposed, would be discussed with the full council.
