Shared Governance Committee (SGC)

Purpose (Charge): The SGC is charged with **monitoring** policy and activity related to faculty shared governance and **recommending action** to the Senate according to the responsibilities outlined in GR V B charge 5.

Authority: The SGC does not have any final decision-making authority but advises the Faculty Senate on matters related to its charge.

Membership: Recommended by the Senate, appointed by the Faculty Senate Chair, and approved by the Senate, The SGC shall be composed of at least three faculty senators to conduct business and ensure representation of a range of faculty title series. The committee may include ex-officio members, including representatives of other shared governance bodies. The SGC will select a voting Faculty Senator from the committee membership to chair the committee.

Duties:

- Consider issues related to shared governance and University regulations.
- Coordinate representation of the views of the faculty to the President and other shared governance bodies. All Interactions of Faculty Senate to express these views must go through the administrative liaison as per GR V.
- Share their findings and concerns with the Faculty Senate on a regular basis.

Duration & Reporting: This is a standing committee that has no termination date. Regular activity reports will be submitted at least once a semester and an annual report will be submitted in August of each year.
