AR Review Summary from Faculty Senators – 4.27.2026

General Feedback

- Both ARs are reasonable in intent but need clarification on items listed below.
- Continues the trend of reducing regulations and replacing them with simple declarations of the chain of command (i.e., who decides policy rather than what policy will be). This makes the rules less stable and subject to arbitrary decision making.

Administrative Regulation — Student Fees

- Concerns about weakened student protections, including:
 - Less strict limits tying fees to actual costs.
 - Reduced protections for online/off-campus students.
- Requests for clearer limits on fees and a more transparent review process.

Administrative Regulation — Contracting Authority, Procurement, and Disposal

- Concerns about centralization and loss of distributed decision-making roles. For example, the specialized nature of technology by splitting responsibility for the selection and management of resources.
- Removal of key procedural details raises transparency and accessibility issues.
- The faculty need to confirm that existing specialized delegations remain intact, specifically in the College of Medicine.
- Disciplinary language requires clear, accessible policies before enforcement.
